IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Kineowatha Camps Inc., of Wilton, to Reimburse for Removal of Floating Bog, on Wilson Lake.

Kineowatha Camps Inc. compensated for removal of floating bog. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$500, to be paid Kineowatha Camps Inc., of Wilton, Maine, as a settlement in full for all claims against the state of Maine, for removal of floating bog on the shores of Wilson Lake in the town of Wilton, said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.
