STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Baker Pond.

Fishing in Baker Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing, Baker Pond in township 5, range 6, B. K. P., W. K. R., Somerset county, except fly fishing during the general open season on Wednesday of each week and to prohibit taking more than 10 fish in all per person per day or more than 5 pounds of fish in all unless the last fish taken increases the combined weight thereof to more than 5 pounds.
