STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of Members of City Governments to Certain Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Members of city governments ineligible for certain offices. No member of the board of aldermen or council of any city having a population of over 40,000 inhabitants shall during the term for which he was chosen, or within a period of 2 years next succeeding the termination of his term of office, be eligible for any other office of emolument in said city, where the incumbent of said office is selected or appointed by the city manager, or by the aldermen or council of said city; nor shall he during such term or such period hold any such office.
