STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Carrie E. Fitch.

Pension for Carrie E. Fitch repealed. Resolved: That that part of chapter 98 of the resolves of 1931 which provides for a state pension for Carrie E. Fitch be, and hereby is, repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Since Carrie E. Fitch was granted a Special Pension by the State of Maine, she has been allowed a Federal pension which is sufficient for her support and she is no longer in need of aid from this State.
