STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Rate of Interest Charged by Small Loan Agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 150, amended. Section 150 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 150. Amount of loan and rate of interest limited. Every person, copartnership and corporation licensed hereunder may loan any sum of money, goods, or choses in action not exceeding in amount or value the sum of \$300, and may charge, contract for, and receive thereon interest at a rate not to exceed three percent $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ per month provided, however, that a minimum charge of not exceeding 25 cents shall be allowable in all cases. No person shall owe any licensee at any time more than \$300 for principal.'
