# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Addie L. Coombs of Montville.

**Pension for Addie L. Coombs, increased. Resolved:** That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Addie L. Coombs, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Addie L. Coombs was granted a State Pension of \$8 per month by Chapter 117, Resolves of 1917. This amount is not sufficient for her present needs.
