STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Making of Local Regulations for Fishing and Game Sanctuaries.

Amend said bill by striking out in the 24th line of said bill the word "may" and substituting therefor the word 'shall'; and by adding after the word "lie" in the 26th line thereof the following words: 'and the representative to the legislature from the city, town or class district and the senators of the then existing legislature from the county within which said waters or lands to be affected lie'.

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 27th line the words: "upon the expiration of the period during which said hearings are to be held the commissioner with the advice and consent of the advisory council", and substituting in place thereof the following: 'after the holding of the hearing the commissioner with the advice and consent of the member of the advisory council, the representative and the senators aforesaid'.
