STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Drivers' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Poll-tax must be paid before obtaining driver's license. Before a license to operate a motor vehicle shall be issued, the person applying for such license must exhibit to the secretary of state a proper receipt for his poll-tax for the current year.
