STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing for Salmon in Penobscot River.

Fishing for salmon in Penobscot river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation making the open season for fishing for salmon, except by fly-fishing, so-called, in the Penobscot river, from May I to August 15 of each year. The said commissioner is hereby directed to repeal all rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions hereof.
