## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing.

**Emergency Preamble.** Whereas, the laws relating to ice fishing passed since 1931 have placed restrictions on fishing for pickerel that prevent many citizens of the state from obtaining food that they need; and

Whereas, the laws prevailing in 1931 provided adequate protection against the abuse of ice fishing privileges by the right of petition of the municipal officers to the commissioner of inland fisheries and game; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Laws relating to ice fishing passed since 1931 repealed. All of the acts, parts of acts, and resolves, relating to ice fishing passed since the regular session of 1931 are hereby repealed.

**Emergency Clause.** In view of the emergency created as recited in the preamble this act shall take effect when approved.
