## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Charter of the People's Ferry Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1885, c. 495, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 495 of the private and special laws of 1885, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 11. Authorizing the appropriation to be made annually. The City of Portland may shall annually raise a sum not exceeding \$10,000 for the following purposes: To aid in defraying the expenses of securing adequate transportation service for passengers, freight, and vehicles by the People's Ferry Company or any other ferry line, steamboat line or powerboat line, making landings at Portland and any of the islands of Casco bay, and for such purposes the City of Portland may shall enter into such contracts as the city council may determine.'
