IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Poll Taxes

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Persons not to vote until poll tax is paid. No person upon whom a poll tax is levied shall be permitted to vote at any municipal or state election whether regular or special until he has shown to the warden or officer in charge of the election a receipt for his poll tax for the preceding year.
