STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Assenting to the Provisions of the Bankhead-Jones Act, So-Called.

Whereas, there has been enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, "An Act to provide for research into basic laws and principles relating to agriculture and to provide for the further development of cooperative agricultural extension work and the more complete endowment and support of land-grant colleges," approved June 29, 1935, the act of Congress known as Public No. 182-74th Congress, and

Whereas, the provisions of the said act and the purpose of the grants of money authorized by the act are made subject to the legislative assent of the several states and territories, therefore, be it

Bankhead-Jones act, accepted. Resolved: That the state of Maine hereby assents to the provisions and requirements of the act of Congress known as Public No. 182-74th Congress, and that the trustees of the University of Maine be, and hereby are, authorized and empowered to receive the grants of money appropriated under said act, and to cooperate with the federal government under the terms of said act.
