RESOLVE, Opening Certain Waters to Smelt Fishing.

Smelt fishing, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Pennesseewassee lake and Little Pennesseewassee lake, together with the tributaries thereto, in Oxford county, to smelt fishing during the regular smelting season.
