STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 75. Digging out foxes forbidden. No person shall at any time dig out, molest or destroy in any way any fox or raccoon den, den tree or hole, or set any trap in any such den, den tree or hole, or remove or cause to be removed from any such den, den tree or hole, any fox or raccoon except those enclosed in private fox or raccoon ranches.'
