RESOLVE, in Favor of a Rebate of Certain Taxes for the Town of Lincolnville.

Rebate of Certain Taxes for the Town of Lincolnville. Resolved: That the state tax assessor shall from time to time when the state tax is due from the town of Lincolnville compute the proportionate value of the taxable property of the town of Lincolnville that became exempt from taxation because of the creation of the state or national park therein and rebate to the said town of Lincolnville the amount which the said town lost in taxes for that assessment year because of the creation of said park.
