#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Sell Certain Land.

Forestry department authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell the following described lot to Miss Florentine Caron, St. Pamphile, P. Q., Canada for the sum of \$557.94.

All of 296 acres in Township 14, Range 16, W. E. L. S., Aroostook County.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lot, reputed to be owned by Alex and Eugene Caron, of St. Pamphile, P. Q., Canada, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1924 for 1922 taxes. It is understood that Alex Caron, who is a brother of Miss Florentine Caron, is desirous of keeping the ownership in the Caron family where it has been for a generation. The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising to February 1, 1937 amount to \$557.94. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
