## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Regulation of the Use of the Highways by Motor Vehicles Transporting Property for Hire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 146, § 10, amended. Subsection (3) of section 10 (A) of chapter 146 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'(3) While engaged exclusively in the delivery of the United States mail; while engaged exclusively in the transportation of fresh fruits and vegetables from farms to canneries during the canning or packing season; while engaged exclusively in the transportation of milk or cream from farms to gathering stations and creameries and from gathering stations to creameries. Nothing in this act contained shall apply to persons, firms or corporations operating motor vehicles carrying property of which they are the actual and bona fide owners.'
