AN ACT Relative to Possession of Firearms or Fishing Tackle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 108, amended. Section 108 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 108. Possession of firearms or fishing tackle in forests or on waters of state without certificate prima facie evidence of violation of law. The possession of any firearm or fishing tackle in the fields or forests or on the waters or ice of the state by ~~a resident of this state~~ **any person**, unless ~~the said person~~ having such firearm or fishing tackle in possession has in his possession ~~a certificate of registration as herein provided~~, **the required hunting or fishing license**, duly issued to him and covering the period such firearm or fishing tackle is found in his possession, or gives satisfactory evidence of the issuance of such certificates, shall be prima facie evidence of hunting or fishing in violation of law.'
