STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Hunting, Definition of.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 40, par. (a). Paragraph (a) of section 40 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows: 'Hunting means to hunt for, pursue, catch, take, kill, wound, or destroy wild birds and animals.'
