STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Tie Votes in Liquor Referendum Questions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 157, amended. Chapter 157 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended by adding at the end of said chapter the following words:

'In case of a tie vote on any of the preceding questions, the law shall remain as it was before the vote.'
