STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Roadside Improvement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 248, § 1, amended. Section I of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1933, as amended by chapter 121 of the public laws of 1935, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 1. Planting. The state highway commission may, subject to the consent of abutting land owners, cause or allow grasses, shrubs, vines, and trees to be planted and maintained along state and state aid highways, to be paid for as part of the cost of construction and maintenance of highways; this cost not to exceed \$15,000 per year.'
