**RESOLVE, for the Conservation of Clams in the County of Washington.**

---

**Conservation of clams, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that the canning, packing, and barreling of clams, in the county of Washington, and the digging of clams for the purpose of canning, packing, barreling, or for transportation out of the county, between the 16th day of May and the 30th day of September, both days inclusive, and the transportation out of the county of clams dug between the 16th day of May and the 30th day of September, both days inclusive, is hereby prohibited under a penalty of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50 and costs for each offense.
