STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Extend the Rights, Powers and Privileges of The Sabattus Water and Sewer District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1929, c. 48, relating to Sabattus Water and Sewer District, charter extended. The rights, powers and privileges of the Sabattus Water and Sewer District, which were granted by chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1929, are hereby revived and extended for and during a period of 2 years from the date when this act shall take effect; and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said act shall take effect; and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said act shall take effect; and all the rights. Water and Sewer District may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as provided in said act.
