STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Impeachment of Witnesses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 96, § 118-A, additional. Chapter 96 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto, to be numbered section 118-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 118-A. Impeachment of witnesses, regulated. No party shall be precluded from impeaching a witness because the witness is his own.'
