STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Designating a Certain Road as "Pine Tree Trail".

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

"Pine Tree Trail" designated. The road leading from Portland through Auburn, Lewiston, Winthrop, Augusta, Winslow, Waterville, Pittsfield, Newport, Bangor, Orono, Old Town, Lincoln, Mattawamkeag, and Macwahoc, Route A from Macwahoc to Houlton by way of Haynesville Route B—from Macwahoc to Houlton by way of Island Falls, from Houlton to Mars Hill,—Route A from Mars Hill to Fort Kent by way of Presque Isle, Caribou, and Van Buren—Route B—from Mars Hill by way of Ft. Fairfield, Limestone and Van Buren, is hereby designated as the "Pine Tree Trail."
