STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Records of Birth.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 60, amended. Subsection 1 of section 60 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'I. The record of birth shall state its date and place of occurrence, full christian and surname, if named, color and sex of child, whether living or stillborn, **congenital deformities**, and the full christian and surnames, color, occupation, residence and birthplace of parents.'
