IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Penalty for Selling or Giving Liquor to Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 294, repealed. Section 294 of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby repealed.
