**AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Pocumpus Lake and Western Grand Lake,
in Washington County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 28, amended. Section 28 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended so that the last sentence thereof shall read as follows:

‘Except that gill nets of not larger than 1¼ inch mesh may be used in the taking of white fish in Eastern Grand lake and Hot Brook lake in Aroostook and Washington counties and in Baskahegan lake, **Pocumpus lake and Western Grand lake**, all in Washington county, and in Mattawamkeag lake in Aroostook county during the month of November of each year.’
