STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Practice of Optometry Defined.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 21, § 48, last ¶, amended. The last paragraph of section 48 of chapter 21 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'An opthalmic lens within the meaning of this and the following section shall be any lens which has a spherical, cylindrical, or prismatic power or value, and or any lens is ground pursuant to a prescription'.
