STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Termination of Registrations of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 65 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes as amended by section 224 of the public laws of 1931, is hereby further amended to read as follows

'Sec. 65. Registration certificates and licenses to operate, termination of. All registrations of vehicles, all certificates of registration and number plates, and all licenses to operate motor vehicles shall terminate and become void at midnight on the 31st day of December of each year, except as provided in paragraph 2 of section 55 of this chapter; and no person shall operate any motor vehicle on or after the 1st day of January of any vear unless then duly licensed to operate such vehicle for such year.'

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
