STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing for the Exemption from Taxation of Certain Farm Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, amended. Paragraph 6 of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All mules and horses less than 6 months old and all brood mares and horses used in agricultural operations and neat cattle 18 months old and under and all sheep to the number of 35 and swine to the number of 10 and domestic fowl to the number of 50.'
