## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Validating the Withdrawal of the Plantation of Pleasant Ridge from the Maine Forestry District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Validating withdrawal of Pleasant Ridge Plantation from Maine Forestry District. The vote taken on March 9, 1936 by the inhabitants of the plantation of Pleasant Ridge to withdraw from the Maine Forestry District is hereby ratified, confirmed and validated, and said plantation shall cease to be a part of the Maine Forestry District. A copy of such vote certified by the town clerk shall be forwarded forthwith to the treasurer of state and the forest commissioner and from the time such certified copy is filed in the office of the treasurer of state, said plantation shall cease to be a part of the Maine Forestry District.
