STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Confirming the Action of the Town of Cranberry Isles in Taking Over a Certain Wharf and Authorizing the Raising and Expending of Moneys for Maintenance of Same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Action validated. The action of the town of Cranberry Isles in taking over by assignment all rights and interests as conferred by section 1 of chapter 340 of the private and special laws of 1905 to build and maintain a certain wharf into tide waters of Great Cranberry Island in said town of Cranberry Isles is hereby approved, confirmed and validated.

Sec. 2. Maintenance of wharf. The town of Cranberry Isles is hereby authorized to raise and expend moneys for the upkeep and maintenance of a wharf constructed under the provisions of section 1 of this act.
