RESOLVE, Defining Rights of Forest Commissioner.

Authorization to forest commissioner. Resolved: That the authorization given to the forest commissioner, under chapter 22 of the resolves of 1925, to sell and convey consistently with the rights of others, certain lands to Eugenia A. Powers, an actual settler on Township I, Range 7, west from the east line of the state, in Penobscot county, shall be construed to mean the lands occupied by the buildings of Eugenia A. Powers, her grass and tillage land, pasture land, and the adjoining land heretofore cut over.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under chapter 22 of the resolves of 1925 the forest commissioner was authorized to convey to Eugenia A. Powers "certain lands." This resolve is for the purpose of limiting and describing the lands, in accordance with the understanding of the parties.
