RESOLVE, in Favor of the State Park Commission.

State park commission; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year 1937-38, and \$1,000 for the fiscal year 1938-39 to be used for the per diem pay and expenses of a state park commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The citizen members of the State Park Commission receive \$5 per diem for the time actually spent by each in transacting the official business of the commission under section 2, of chapter 124, of the public laws of 1935, and to continue the necessary work of the commission, a sufficient sum must be appropriated for their pay and expenses.
