RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forestry Department to Sell Certain Land.

Forestry department authorized to sell certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to sell the following described lot to the First National Bank of Van Buren for the sum of \$223.33:

Lot 17 containing 130 acres in Township 17, Range 5, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county;

Lot 22 containing 92 acres in Township 17, Range 5, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This property, reputed to be owned by Maxime Marquis, of Fort Kent, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1933 for non-payment of 1931 taxes. The First National Bank of Van Buren holding a mortgage on same desire to take it over by paying the taxes in arrears which figured to February I, 1937 with interest and advertising \$223.33.
