STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Deer in Cumberland and Lincoln Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 61, amended. The 1st 9 lines of section 61 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be an annual closed season on deer in the counties of Androscoggin, <u>Cumberland</u>, Kennebec, Knox, <u>Lincoln</u>, Sagadahoc and Waldo from the 1st day of December of each year to the 31st day of October of the following year, both days inclusive, and in the <u>county</u> counties of Cumberland, Lincoln and York from the 1st 15th day of December of each year to the 10th 14th day of November of the following year, both days inclusive, and in the counties of Aroostook, Penobscot, Somerset, Piscataquis, Franklin, and Oxford from the 1st day of December of each year to the 15th day of October of the following year, both days inclusive.'
