RESOLVE, Authorizing Compensation for Paul F. Fitzpatrick, of Gardiner.

Paul F. Fitzpatrick, compensated. Resolved: That the treasurer of the county of Kennebec, be, and hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed to pay to Paul F. Fitzpatrick, of Gardiner, the sum of \$183.25 for additional services as recorder of the Gardiner municipal court for the period from December 4, 1936 to January 28, 1937.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the period above mentioned, while there was no judge appointed for the Gardiner municipal court, it was necessary for Mr. Fitzpatrick, the recorder of said court, to carry on the duties of judge.
