STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Contracts for Care of Poor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Contracts for care of paupers; regulated. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any city or town to provide for the care of its paupers or other dependent persons under a general contract or agreement for a certain stipulated amount or price per year.
