STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Relating to an Investigation of the Pollution of Rivers in the State.

Public utilities commission authorized to investigate the pollution of the rivers of the state. Resolved: That the public utilities commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to investigate the conditions of pollution in our rivers, and after mature study of the problem presented by this pollution, submit a report to the governor covering same and recommending remedial legislation if such be deemed practical and desirable.

In conducting this investigation and study, the commission may use such powers as it now possesses for obtaining information and data.

This investigation and report shall be completed within I year from the effective date of the passage of this act and \$2500 is hereby appropriated for this purpose.
