### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Westport.

Town of Westport; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the town of Westport, the sum of \$1500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1938, to aid in building a ferry boat, to be used on the Sheepscott river between the towns of Wiscasset and Westport, said funds to be taken from the general fund of the state.

# STATEMENT OF FACTS Their ferry boat at present has been condemned and they can carry only light vehicles.
