## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Recording of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 87, § 33, amended.** Section 33 of chapter 87 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 33. Certificate to be put on deed and source of title given or it cannot be recorded. A certificate of acknowledgment, or proof of execution as aforesaid, must be indorsed on or annexed to the deed, and the grantor must set out in such deed his immediate source of title, and then the deed and certificate may be recorded in the registry of deeds. No deed can be recorded without such certificate and such statement of source of title.'
