STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Consumption of Liquor on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 157, § 17, amended. Section 17 of chapter 157 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended by adding to the 10th paragraph thereof the following words:

'provided, however, that not more than I license for the consumption of liquor on the premises where sold shall be issued for each 1000 population or major portion thereof.'
