STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Legalizing Amateur Sports and Games Under Certain Conditions on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 245, § 39-A, amended. Section 39-A of chapter 245 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 39-A. Sunday sports legalized. In any town that shall so vote as hereinafter provided, it shall be lawful to engage in as a participant, manager or official, or to attend as a spectator, any outdoor or indoor recreational or competitive amateur sport or game, except boxing, horse-racing, air circuses or wrestling, between the hours of I P. M. and 7 P. M. on Sunday.'
