STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Transportation of Prisoners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 147, § 46, amended. Section 46 of chapter 147 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 46. Removal of convicts to state prison or other state institution; clothing for convict. When a convict is sentenced to confinement in the state prison or other state institution, such clerk shall make out a warrant under seal of the court, directed to the warden of the prison, requiring him to cause such convict, without needless delay, to be removed from the county jail to the state prison or other state institution; the warden and all sheriffs and jail keepers shall strictly obey its directions; and the clerk as soon as may be, shall deliver such warrant to the sheriff of the county, and he shall forthwith deliver it to said warden. The sheriff shall provide the convict with comfortable clothing in which to be removed to the state prison or other institution.'
