IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Reimbursing the Town of Weld for Hospital Treatment for Arthur Pelletier.

Town of Weld; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the town of Weld, the sum of \$788.50 to reimburse said town for hospital treatment for Arthur Pelletier, state pauper.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This man was injured by a horse and taken to Franklin Memorial Hospital where it was necessary for him to remain for 54 days.
