STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Importation of Wild Birds or Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 54, amended. Section 54 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall introduce or import any wild bird or wild animal, except for captivity purposes, or dead body or part thereof, of any kind or species into the state, or receive or have in possession such wild bird or wild animal, or dead body or part thereof, so introduced or imported, without written permission of the commissioner.'
