STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 300, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 300 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(Sec. 2. Salaries and expenses of members. The salary of the chairman of the commission shall be four thousand dollars (\$4000) \$4500 per year, and the salary of each of the other members shall be three thousand dollars (\$3000) \$4000 per year, and in addition each member of the commission shall be allowed his reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of his duties, provided, however, that such expenses shall not include travel between his place of residence and the commission office, or board and lodging in the city or town where such office is located.'
