STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Relating to Game Preserves.

Forbidding swimming, boating or skating in certain limits. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be and hereby is directed to issue a rule and regulation forbidding swimming, boating or skating within the limits of Reservoir No. 1, consisting of an area beginning on Atlantic highway No. 1 at Little River on the land owned by the Belfast Water District and comprises 81.92 acres of which 34.57 acres are flooded; balance being watershed surrounding reservoir; and Reservoir No. 2, consisting of an area beginning at the bridge over Little River located on lower Congress Street and the road known as the Perkins road. This area contains 125.37 acres of which 40 acres are flooded. The balance surrounding the reservoir which forms its banks and also a part of its watershed is owned by the Belfast Water District. This area is flooded by a dam on Little River about 100 feet westerly and above foresaid bridge.
